Safeguarding Code of Conduct for Children and Young People

Responsibilities of Warrambui Staff

Warrambui staff will:

- Do our best to make sure that you are safe from harm;
- Wear a uniform and/or a name badge so you know who they are;
- Support and assist you while you are staying at **Warrambui**;
- Not be alone with you where we cannot be seen by other **Warrambui** staff, camp leader, teacher or parent/carer;
- Have your camp leader, teacher or parent/carer with you if we need to provide transport to you.
- Ask you and your parents/guardians before we take pictures of you;
- Not visit you at your home or meet with you away from a Warrambui camp;
- Not call, text or email you or make contact with you on social media;
- Will not give you gifts without asking your camp leader, teacher or parent/carer;
- Give you guidance that is fair, respectful and appropriate to your age and background; and
- Help you and other children and young people if you feel unsafe, uncomfortable or upset.

Responsibilities of Children and Young People at Warrambui

When you come to stay at **Warrambui** you also have to behave positively by:

- Telling a staff person, camp leader, teacher or parent if you feel unsafe, upset or uncomfortable;
- Treating other children and adults with respect;
- Following the rules of the activity, event or program;
- Listening to others, being kind and not stopping other children or young people from enjoying a program;
- Asking your camp leader, teacher or parent/carer if you need to leave the activity.
